In the name of God Amen I Thomas Pope of Malmesbury County of Wilts Mason being weak of body but of [missing] & p[er]fect memory (thanks be to the Almighty) there fore do this 14 day of June Ano D[omi]ni 1675make and ordaine this my last Will and Testament in manner & forme following That is to say. Ffirst I give unto my Deare wife Mary one obligation for tenne pound upon Arthur Parkridge of Milborne bearing date 26th day of March Ano 1670 Likewise I give her ye house I now live in w[i]th all my right title & Estate therein Likewise I give her Three Beds w[i]th all the materiall and furniture there unto belonging And Likewise I give unto my layd dear wife all other my Goods Cathe and Chattles whatsoever both within doore and without, to her owne p[ro]per use and behoofe Alwise provided shed doe her utmost according to her ability to breed up my children in ye best manner she can And that shed pay unto my Eldest daughter Anne ye sume of Twenty shillings when she comes to age and to my two Sonnes Thomas and James tenne shillings a

piece to be payd to them severally when the shall be of age. And I do hereby nominate and appoint my D. dear wife full and Sole Exerutrix of this my last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and Seal yd day & jeare abovest
