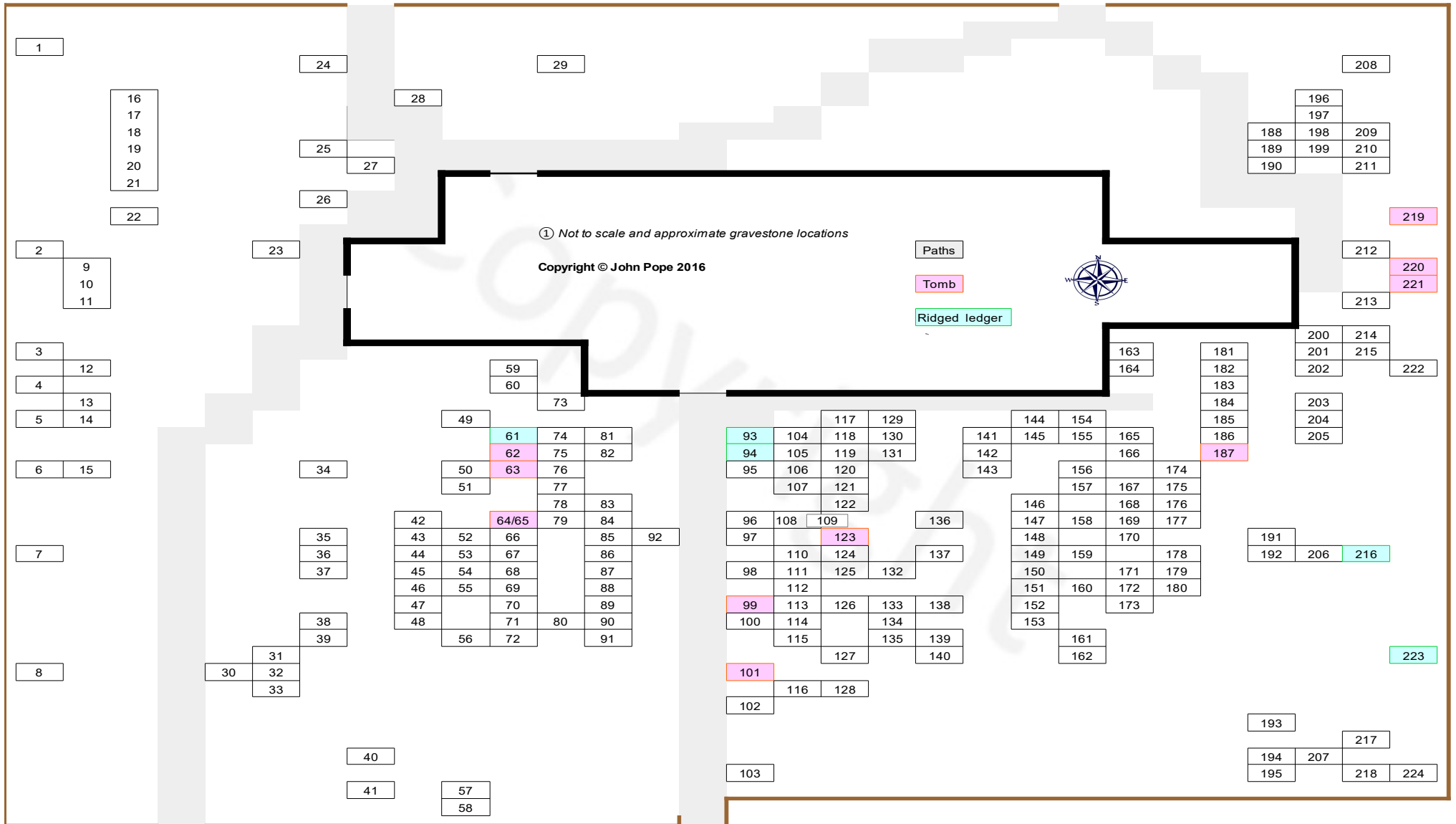

Pulham *St. Mary Magdalen* is a considerable village, about a mile north of the above [Pulham St. Mary], on the abrupt acclivities of a riverlet, 4 miles N.N.W. Of Harleston. Its parish contains 1046 inhabitants, and 2500 acres of land, part of which is in three large commons. It includes the hamlets of *Colegate-end*, *Bush-green*, and *Gresham-green*, and is all in Robt/ Copeman, Esqr's *manor of Pulham*, except a small part lying in the Dean and Chapter of Ely's *manor of Winston*; but the soil belongs to a number of copyholders. The village is said to have anciently had a *market*, and it has still a *fair* for cattle, &c., on the third Thursday in May. It was once famous for the manufacture of hats, dornecks and coverlets; and here are still a few weavers employed by the Norwich manufacturers. The CHURCH is a large edifice, with a square tower and six bells, nave, chancel, aisles, and a handsome north porch. The rectory is consolidated with *Pulham St. Mary the Virgin*. The old *Church and Poor's land* is 70a., let for £100 a year. About four years ago, 29 acres were enclosed from the commons by the overseers, to be cultivated by the paupers, by spade husbandry. The *Hall*, anciently the seat of a younger branch of the Percy family, is now thr property of Mr. John Crickmore. The POST-OFFICE is at John Rayson's; letters are received at 3 afternoon, and des. 8 mng.
